## Chairman's Welcome

<u>Apologies</u> – received from – Michael Scott, David Scott, Alan Weighell, Ken Ridgeway

<u>Minutes of the previous meeting - Matters arising</u> – There has been no further progress on GLEAM until March.

- 1. The Spiota bench near the ford will bear the inscription "Donated by Stokesley Pride in our Town."
- 2. Regarding the bench in memory of Eric contact will be made with the Stokesley Society who have expressed a wish to be included in this, and also with Lynn Southern. The plan put forward for consideration is for two benches and a raised flower trough to be sited near Stokesley Motors on the river bank. The area to be paved so that a pleasant seating area will be created.

<u>Thursday Work</u> – It was thought that the first Thursday in February might be too cold to work but Linda will see if anyone turns up. Chickweed in the tubs and some deadheading is needing to be tackled and one conifer is needing to be replaced. The area outside Spears Travel could do with some attention and also the Market Place. Mike Irving mentioned that a person in Rotary has all the right authority to do weed killing.
