The Memorial Garden

The parish council have agreed to the memorial garden. Work cannot begin until the tree adjacent to the site has been felled. The latter is under a preservation order. Some thought had been given to having the tree carved but after a full discussion it was agreed by SPIOTA members that it was not viable.

A detailed plan of the garden will need to be submitted to the parish council.

Seats

Peter Dobson has begun to clean and oil some of the seats. It was agreed that the parish council be approached about re-siting the two seats underneath the large tree on West Green. These both get encrusted with lichen and fouled by bird droppings. Ken and Linda will review the remaining seats and the necessary slats for repairing will be ordered and fitted as soon as possible.

The Mill Wheel Site

The black liner has been removed and more plants have been put in. Fred has arranged for some paving flags which have been taken up in Stokesley to be delivered to the site. Matty Peacock has agreed to lay them in front and to one side of the wheel.

Planting

It was agreed that the conifers stay in the tubs for the Winter. The conifers from the ziggurat which are now too big will be used for tubs e.g. those on West Green which do not have a conifer. New small ones will be used in the ziggurat.

Next year the conifers in the tubs which are now getting too big will be replaced with small cordylines.
