Minutes of the previous meeting – Matters Arising –

- 1. Seats Work is still on-going the seat outside the chip shop will take all the laths we have- more to be ordered. The hexagonal seats will be cleaned and oiled very soon. The rest will be dealt with after the summer planting work.
- 2. The Town signs Log edging has been added to the Tanton road sign. The rest will be done as they are replanted.
- 3. Trish was thanked for producing a new sponsor list. Bear Necessities will take over sponsorship of the Library bed. £250 will be charged for 3 signs at the small Neasham's roundabout. Rainbow will be asked to provide 10 new tubs.
